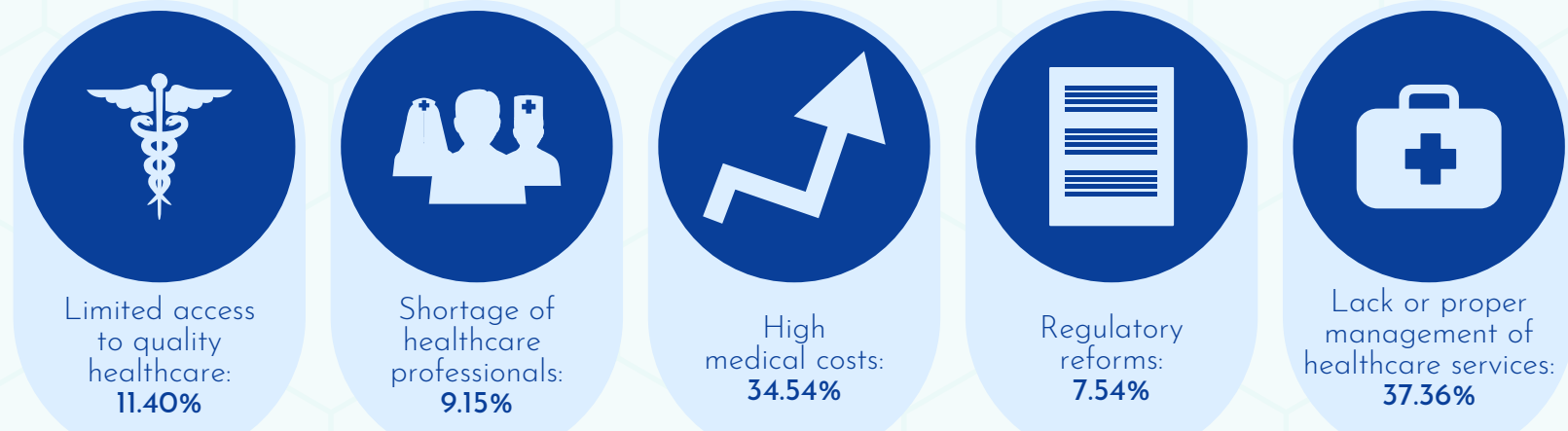
General Perception of Healthcare Services (Public and Private)

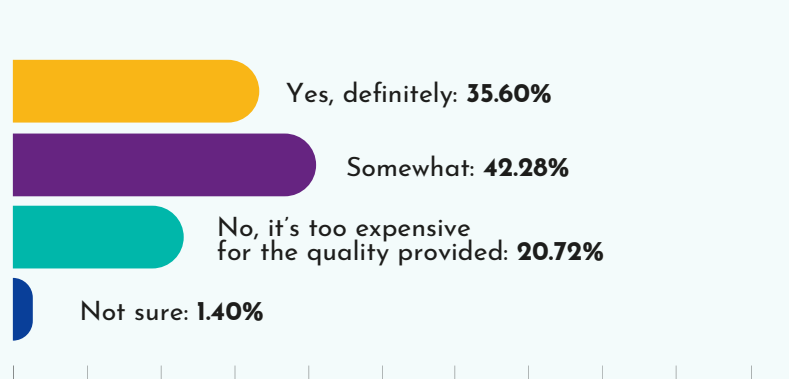


What do you believe is the biggest challenge facing healthcare in South Africa?

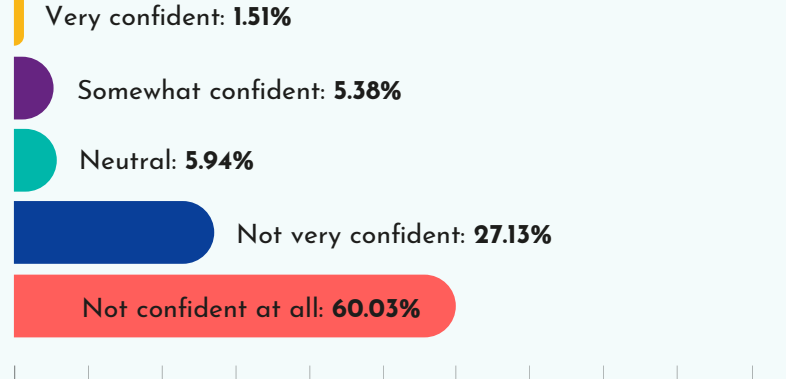


Private vs. Public Healthcare

What improvements would you like to see in the public healthcare system for you to want to access these services?

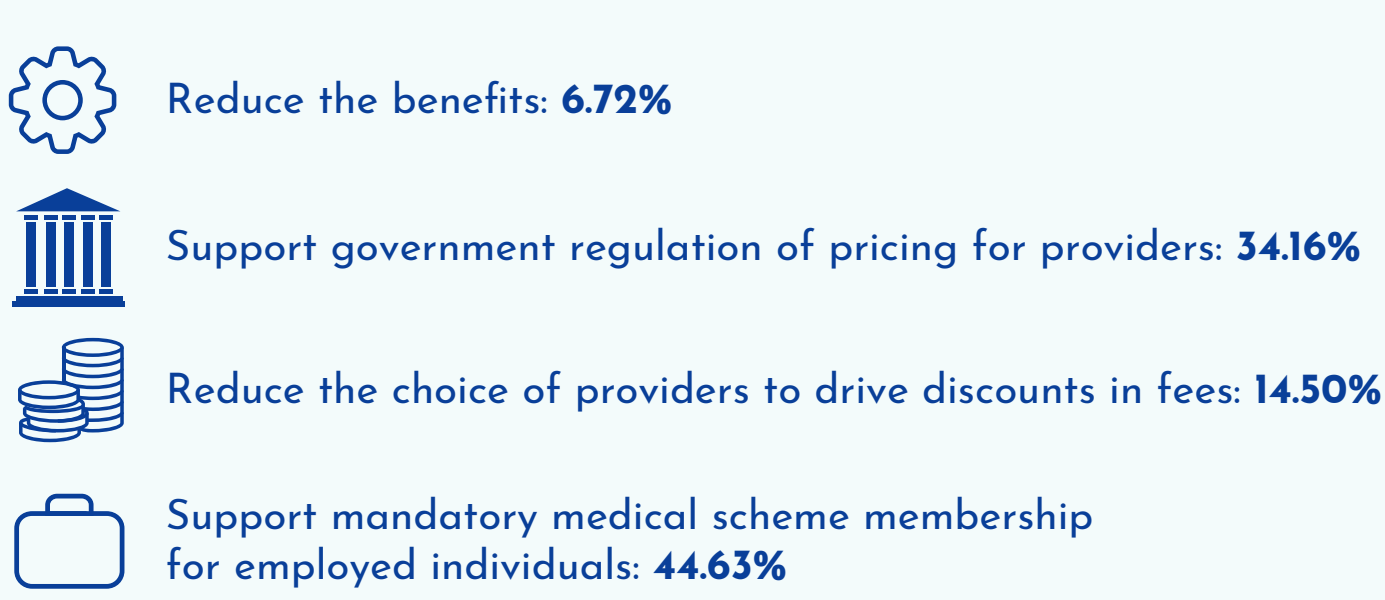


Affordability & Medical Aid

How satisfied are you with your current medical aid benefits?

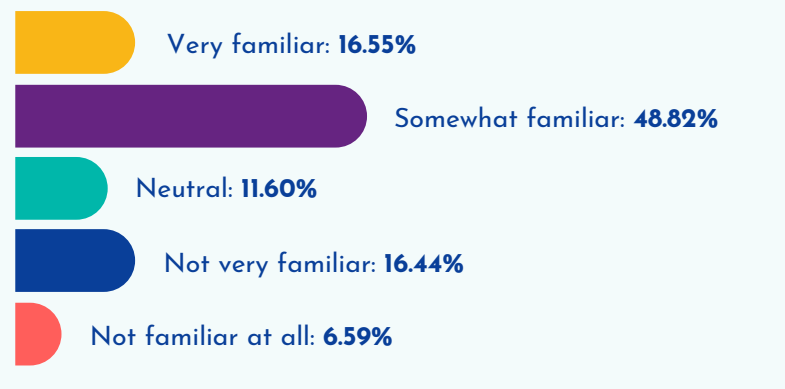


What would you do to make medical schemes more affordable?

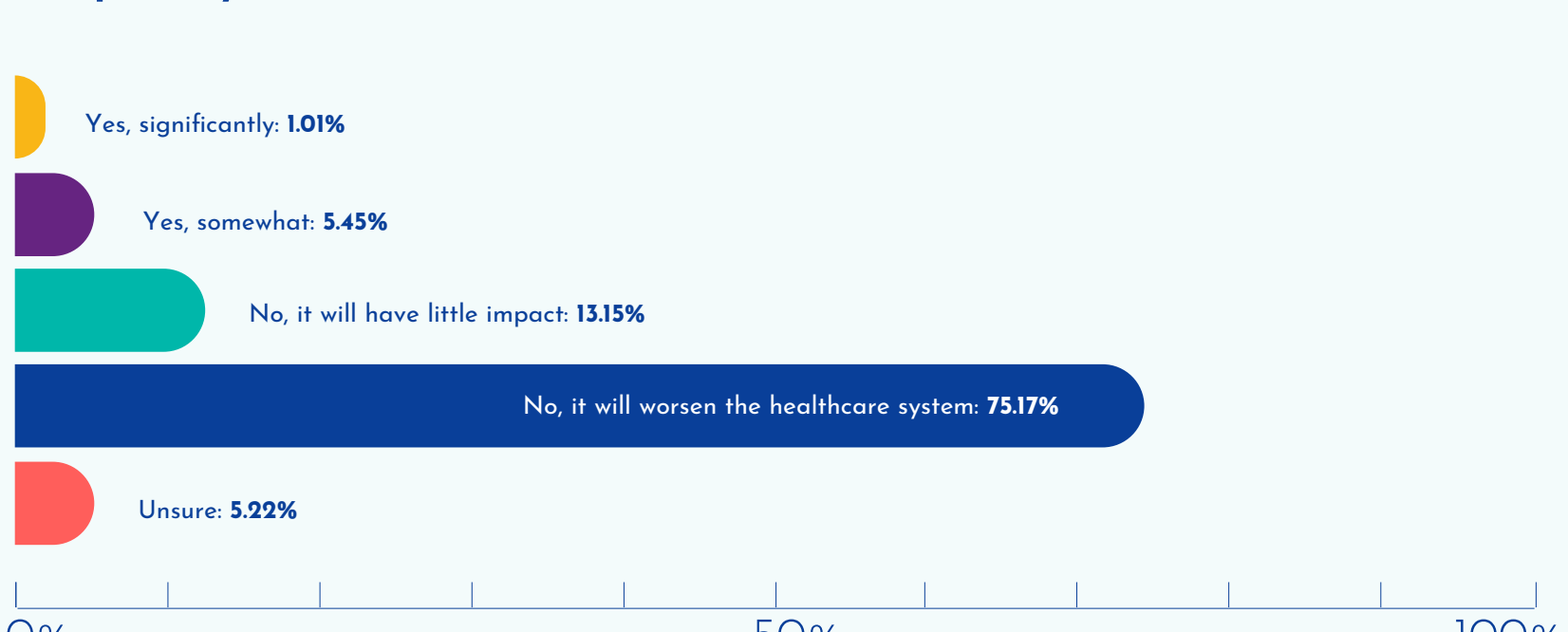


Healthcare Policy & Reforms

How familiar are you with the National Health Insurance (NHI) and its potential impact?

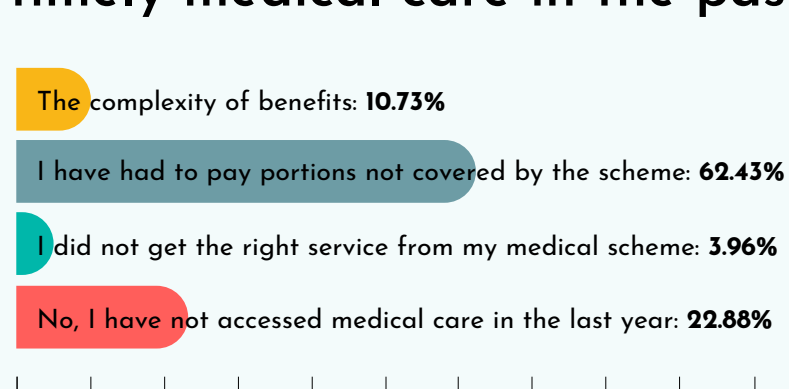


Do you believe the introduction of NHI will improve access to quality healthcare for all South Africans?

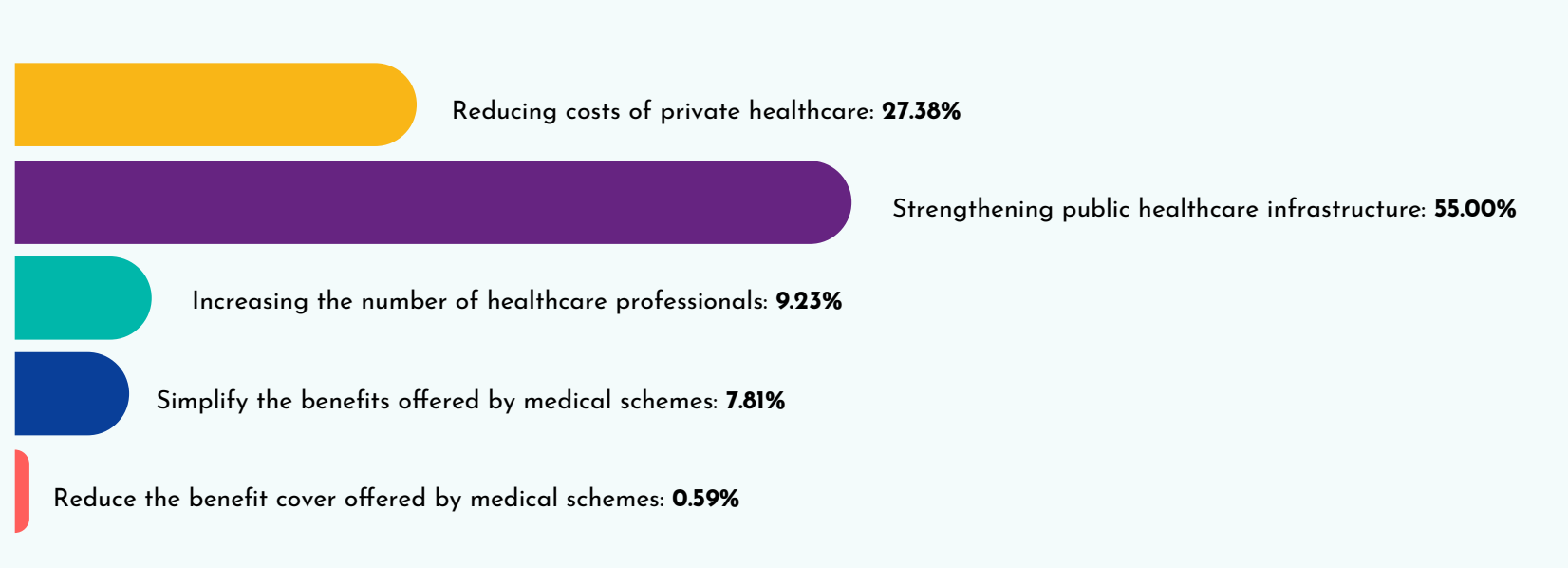


Affordability & Medical Aid
