



The EBnet Evolutionary Awards – terms & conditions

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

An evolution is a development that has taken place in your business within the last 12 months that is unique and/or differentiated from your peers and has a positive impact within one of the categories.

- EBnet's Editorial Committee ("the Committee") reserves the right to reject any entry based on their discretion.
- Should the Committee believe that an entry does not qualify as an entry, they will engage the entrant giving them an opportunity to revise their entry.
- Any late entries, videos or supporting documentation will result in an entrant's disqualification.
- The Committee reserves the right to change the category in which the entry has been submitted for appropriateness.
- Not meeting the entry requirements, for example, maximum number of words allowed, will result in disqualification.
- By entering the awards, the entrant agrees that EBnet may publish their entry on the EBnet website and any social media (or other) platforms they use for promotion.

VOTING

- Each conference attendee has one vote per award category.
- Conference attendees may vote for their own organisation's entry.

The voting process will be audited by independent auditors selected by the Committee (this year, BDO). Voting results will be normalised by the independent auditors for any abnormalities according to a pre-defined formula (verified by an independent actuary) to ensure fairness.

WINNERS WILL RECEIVE

The winner in each category will receive:

- A full spec placement ad on EBnet's Innovation and Technology page for 12 months.
- Personal profiling of the Evolution by the Editor on the EBnet home page and on EBnet's social media platforms.
- A space on the notice board of EBnet's landing page for the next 12 months.

This prize is worth approximately R200 000 and is not negotiable nor transferable.
